

Babysitter Job Description - Seasonal Exempt

Job Summary - As a babysitter you go into the customers personal residence being a condo, hotel or home to babysit children age newborn to teens. Flexible schedule, as you are only asked to work when you are available, being that days, evenings or both.

Job Responsibilities, including but not limited to:

- Keeping the play area safe and free from hazards while monitoring children consistently throughout the day.
- Changing diapers, dressing children and assisting them with their snacks, drinks and meals as needed.
- Teach children the importance of good personal hygiene and health habits, including the importance of brushing teeth, eating healthy food, using the toilet and getting adequate rest.
- Engaging in educational activities with children, including reading, crafts, drawing, coloring and singing.
- Sanitizing play equipment, games and toys on a regular basis to keep them safe and attractive while minimizing the spread of germs. Washing your hands regularly.
- Keep an individual record for each child that includes information about his or her behaviors, daily activities, meals eaten, medications received and other important and mundane details. Discuss this information with each child's parents on a daily basis.
- Discipline unruly children as needed, focusing on using creative ways to encourage good behavior such as picking up after themselves, participating in play and treating each other kindly.

Job Skills & Qualifications

- 20 years of age or older
- High school diploma or equivalent
- 1 year or more of previous childcare experience, especially comfortable with infants
- Ability to pass a background check
- Current CPR certification, including child and infant

Compensation

Sitters are paid by the hour depending on how many children are under your care. Starting November 1, 2021 sitters are paid \$15 per hour 1 child - \$17 per hour 2 children - \$19 per hour 3 children - \$21 per hour 4 children - \$20 per hour for group reservations with 2 or more sitters *\$1 raise on all reservations if you are on the active list and working for SBC for every 3 years or 6 seasons (do not have to be consecutive)

You will be compensated \$200 per week on weeks where you are available but there are no reservations on the calendar from Steamboat Resorts Opening day through Closing day. You will also be compensated with a Merchant Ski pass to Steamboat Ski Resort. If at any time you get a second job, quit SBC or work less than 35 hours for multiple consecutive weeks, your compensation and ski pass will be revoked, and you will be asked to pay the remaining balance on your ski pass.
